PARENTS AND CAMPERS PLEASE READ:

- *Camp regulations and daily schedules will follow.*
- *Cabin assignments are made prior to camp and are final. You will be able to pick one person to bunk with.*
- *Electronic games, DVD's, tobacco, alcohol, drugs, and fireworks are **not allowed**. Christian music is the only music allowed at camp. All headsets and mp3 players must remain in your cabin at all times.*
- *There is a cellphone provided for emergency use. All outside calling must be approved by camp personnel.*

- *All medications coming to camp must be kept and administered by the counselor. Label medication with the camper's name and exact instructions. We have a medic on site at all times. If you feel he needs to be aware of anything, please send note with exact instructions with student. The student is responsible to pass this information on to the EMT or counselor.*

Camp Details

Camp will be held at Sky Mountain Campground, located in the Sierra Mountains approx. 1 1/2 hours from Sacramento on I-80 in the Yuba Gap vicinity. The grounds include a lake, plenty of flat play area for soccer, football and other activities; indoor basketball arena, cabins, and dining hall.

Directions from Sacramento or Bay Area:

Take Interstate 80 east to Yuba Gap Exit. Turn right on Lake Valley Road. Follow signs for Sky Mountain Christian Camp. Approximately 3 miles from Interstate 80.

Directions from Reno:

Take Interstate 80 West over Donner Summit to Yuba Gap Exit. Left over freeway. Right on Lake Valley Road. Follow signs for Sky Mountain Christian Camp. Approximately 3 miles from Interstate 80.

Directions via Highway 20:

Take Highway 20 east through Nevada City to Interstate 80 west. One mile to Yuba Gap Exit. Left over freeway. Right on Lake Valley Road. Follow signs for Sky Mountain Christian Camp. Approximately 3 miles from Interstate 80.
